## ROADS END 2007 Oregon Pinot Noir

At Roads End, the Pacific Ocean meets the Northern Oregon coast, sending cool breezes across the coastal range into the rolling hills of the river valley. These are ideal conditions for the slow ripening that gives Pinot Noir its complexity.

Bold and long, this forward Pinot shows rich black and bright red fruits accented with elegant spice. The intricate layering originates in the volcanic and sedimentary soils of the three vineyards sourced for this vintage: Nysa, Meredith Mitchell, and our own Russell-Grooters estate vineyard.
